Instructions For iPhone and iPad users

- Downloading directly to your device:

- Download the .epub attachment in the email you received
- In Safari, click 'Open in iBooks'
- The book should now appear on your shelf in iBooks

- Downloading to your computer for iPhone and iPad users:

- On your computer, download the .epub attachment from the email you received.
- Open iTunes and go to File > Add to Library
- Select the .epub file and click Open
- The file should now be in your Library under Books
- With your iPad/iPhone connected to your computer, drag the file from Books in your Library to Books on your device
- Depending on your settings the book may now appear on your device or you may need to sync
 it manually

Instructions For Kindle users

- Plug the Kindle into your computer
- On your computer, download the .mobi attachment from the email you received.
- Click the 'Computer' shortcut in the 'Start' menu. On Mac systems, open a new Finder window. Double-click the 'Kindle' drive to open it
- Browse to the location of your .mobi file on your computer
- Drag the .mobi file to the Kindle 'documents' folder to copy it to the Kindle.
- Eject the Kindle drive from your computer.
- You can also email the file to your Kindle email account. Full instructions can be found on the Kindle help page, under Personal Document settings.
